THE MOVIE: SUMMARY

The following is a scene-by-scene comparison of the movie to the corresponding chapters in the book.

THE MOVIE: CHAPTER 1

Opening scene: Elizabeth Bennet walks through the English countryside reading a book as she walks. (*ERROR:* Not in the book. In the book the opening scene is a conversation between Mr. and Mrs. Bennet about marrying off their daughters) Elizabeth still reading walks past a clothesline full of laundry into her house where her sister Mary is playing the piano and the other sisters are playing games. (*ERROR:* Not in the book) Elizabeth overhears her parents' conversation about marrying off all their daughters. (*ERROR:* Not in the book) Mrs. Bennet tells her husband that the Netherfield Park estate has been bought by a rich, single gentleman, Mr. Bingley. (*ACCURATE*) Mrs. Bennet insists that her husband go to visit Mr. Bingley at once, keeping in mind that they have five daughters to marry off. (*ACCURATE*) Mr. Bennet surprises his family with the news that has already visited Mr. Bingley. (*ACCURATE*) The mother and daughters rejoice when Mr. Bennet says that Mr. Bingley will be at the ball tomorrow. (*ACCURATE*)
